RESOLVE, in Favor of Melbourne Wilson, of Guilford.

Melbourne Wilson; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$21 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Melbourne Wilson, of Guilford, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident occurred on November 4, 1943 in the town of Monson, and was investigated by game warden M. R. Sampson. Mr. Wilson's car was damaged to the extent of: right head light total damage, grill total damage, right grill wing damaged.
