AN ACT Relating to the Police Commission for the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Article XI, § 1, amended. Section 1 of Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘No more than 2 members of the police commission shall be registered in the same political party at the time of appointment; provided, however, that a majority of said commission shall be chosen from those enrolled as members of that party in said city of Lewiston which polled the plurality of votes in said city for governor in the last gubernatorial election preceding the date of appointment. To be eligible for appointment, a member of such commission shall be registered in the party he represents at least 6 months prior to the date of appointment, and provided also that he shall not have been registered in any other party within 1 year prior to the time of appointment.’
