RESOLVE, Granting a State Pension to Maud Lowell Tuffs, of Lewiston.

Maud Lowell Tuffs; state pension for. Resolved: That a pension of \$40 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Maud L. Tuffs, of Lewiston, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1945 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Maud Tuffs is the daughter of a civil war veteran and greatly in need of the money.
