RESOLVE, Granting a State Pension to Dana E. Smith of Guilford.

Dana E. Smith; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$25 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Dana E. Smith, of Guilford, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1945 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Smith is now 36 years old. When he was 2 years old, he was stricken with infantile paralysis and since that time he hasn't been able to do much. His sister has helped support him but she is no longer able to do so.
