**RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Everett Pelkey,
of Mapleton.**

Everett Pelkey; pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$30 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Everett Pelkey, of Mapleton, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Said pension shall begin July 1, 1945, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

That part of chapter 145 of the resolves of 1941 which provides for a state pension for Everett Pelkey, of Mapleton, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Everett Pelkey, of Mapleton, is now 54 years of age. He was born a hunchback and because of his physical handicap has never been able to earn a sufficient amount to take care of his needs. His mother who formerly received O. A. A. has died since 1941 when the legislature granted Mr. Pelkey \$10 per month.

He is now in urgent need of an increase in his special resolve pension.
