**AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Recorder of the Ellsworth
Municipal Court.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1903, c. 285, § 7, amended. Section 7 of chapter 285 of the private and special laws of 1903 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 7. Salary of recorder. The recorder of said court shall receive as compensation a salary of ~~four hundred dollars~~ \$500 per year to be paid quarterly from the treasury of the county of Hancock, and in addition thereto he shall receive fees in all civil cases.'
