RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Parkman.

Town of Parkman; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Parkman, the sum of \$1000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1946, and the sum of \$1000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1947, to aid in repairing the road starting at the end of improved road leading from the Dexter road, so called, toward Cobb's Mills, so called, to the four corners, thence west past the residence of J. T. Smart.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road, when completed, will connect improved roads. It will help in transporting farm produce and school children.
