**RESOLVE, to Aid in Construction of a Bridge in Township 31, MD,
Washington County.**

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated the sum of \$1,750 to aid in the construction of a bridge spanning Old Stream in Township 31, MD, Washington county. Any unexpended balance at the end of the fiscal year shall be available for construction of the same in any succeeding year, said sum to apply to the township's part of said bridge built under the bridge act and to be paid from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Air Line Road, so called, is utilized principally as a through route from Bangor, Maine, to communities in the eastern part of Washington county. The present bridge across Old Stream in Township 31 MD is adequate for local needs, and said Township should not be required to bear any of the cost of the new bridge constructed for the benefit of through traffic on the Air Line Road.
