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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Wellington.**

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**Town of Wellington; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Wellington, the sum of \$2000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1946, and the sum of \$2000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1947, to aid in repairing the road starting at the end of the improved road east of Burdin's corner, so called, and extending east toward the Parkman town line.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Six-tenths of a mile of dirt road in the middle of 13 miles of improved road is impassable spring and fall. The road is a stage route.
