STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Oxford County to Fred J. Lovejoy, of West Bethel.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Fred J. Lovejoy, of West Bethel, whatever interest the state has in Lot 7, R. 3, part Lot 6, R. 3, and part Lots 6 and 7, R. 2, Fryeburg Academy Grant in Mason, containing 235 acres, for the sum of \$225.39.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land was purchased by Mr. Lovejoy about 1919, but because of lack of cash, in 1923 he gave a mortgage on the property and in 1936 there was a foreclosure. He now wishes to purchase the property back and a check for \$225.39 for back taxes is now in the hands of the treasurer of state.
