#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Exemption from Registration Fees of Certain Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 19, § 55, sub-§I, amended. Subsection I of section 55 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- **1.** Any motor truck, tractor, or trailer brought into the state and used exclusively herein for **rides**, **so** called, **or** display purposes in agricultural or industrial fairs, or in motor vehicle exhibitions. Provided, however, that the state or country under which said vehicle, or tractor, is registered grants like privileges to like vehicles, or tractors, registered in this state, and to operators thereof.'
