STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Amending the Charter of the Preachers' Aid Society of the Maine Conference of the Methodist Church.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1923, c. 26, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 26 of the private and special laws of 1923 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 3. Powers and privileges. Said corporation shall be capable of having, holding and taking in fee simple, by gift, grant, devise or otherwise, lands, tenements and other estate, real and personal, to the amount of three hundred thousand dollars \$500,000, and shall have all the powers, rights and privileges granted to or required by said original corporations united by this act, under and by virtue of the respective acts incorporating the same, in as full and ample manner as the same were enjoyed by either of them, and shall be subject to all the duties, obligations and liabilities of the original corporations, and the laws of this state, to the same extent that the original bodies corporate would have been had this act not been passed.'
