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**AN ACT Relating to the Wells and Kennebunk Game Preserve.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 33, § 90, amended.** That part of section 90 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes which relates to Wells and Kennebunk game preserve is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Wells ~~and Kennebunk~~: The following described tract, or territory, situated in the ~~towns town~~ of Wells ~~and Kennebunk~~, in the county of York, to wit:

A certain tract of land ~~consisting of 2,500 acres, more or less~~, bounded and described as follows: On the east by the Atlantic ocean; on the south by the Drake island road, so called; on the west by the ~~Atlantic Shore Highway~~ **U. S. Number 1 Highway**, so called; on the north by the ~~Mousam river town line of Kennebunk and Wells.~~
