**AN ACT to Increase Salaries of Judge and Recorder of the Millinocket
Municipal Court.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1909, c. 393, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 393 of the private and special laws of 1909, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Salaries of judge and recorder increased. The judge shall receive a salary, in full for all services, of ~~twelve hundred dollars~~ **\$1,800** per annum to be paid him by the county of Penobscot, and the recorder a salary of ~~six hundred dollars~~ **\$1,000** per annum, payable quarterly.'
