STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Maine Development Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 35, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 35 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows: 'The sum of \$161,000 is annually appropriated for the purpose of The purpose of the appropriation is for the advertising and publicly setting forth and displaying agricultural, industrial, and recreational resources, activities, and attractions of the state.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 35, § 3, repealed and replaced. Section 3 of chapter 35 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and replaced to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 3. Unexpended balances. All unexpended balances, remaining at the end of any fiscal year, shall be a continuing carrying account, to be expended in the succeeding year for the purposes provided for in this chapter.'
