RESOLVE, in Favor of Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Penobscot Tribe of Indians; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2500 from the general fund of the state to be paid to the Penobscot Tribe of Indians for the purpose of constructing a receiving vault for the dead; and be it further

Resolved: That such construction be under the direction and supervision of the department of health and welfare.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Penobscot Tribe of Indians have no vault now for the dead and it is necessary that one be constructed.
