STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Moscow.

Town of Moscow; reimbursed. Resolved: That the treasurer of state be, and hereby is, authorized to reimburse the town of Moscow the sum of \$426.17, which sum was paid under protest for interest on state taxes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On January 1, 1941, the state owed the town of Moscow \$16,000 and the town of Moscow owed the state \$11,000 on state taxes. Due to the fact that the state did not pay what they owed to the town of Moscow on January 1, 1941, the town had to keep back what they owed to the state. The state subsequently charged the town 6% interest from January 1, 1941 to August 27, 1941 and the town should be reimbursed in the amount of the interest.
