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**AN ACT Relating to Membership in the Maine Teachers' Retirement  
System.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 37, § 222, sub-§ I, amended.** Subsection I of section 222 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**‘I.** All teachers who shall serve in the public schools, or in any academy ~~which has contract relations with a town under the provisions of section 96 and~~ which receives at least 3/5 of its support from the state ~~or town appropriations,~~ or who teach in a normal school which is under the control of the state, or members of the department of education, on or after July 1, 1924, may become members of the association, upon application to and approval by a majority of the retirement board and under such rules and regulations as it may prescribe.’
