## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Liquor Licenses in Unorganized Territory Where No Elections Are Held.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 2, sub-§ V, amended. Subsection V of section 2 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding before the last paragraph thereof the following:

'In unorganized territory where no elections are held, no licenses shall be issued.'
