STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Salary of County Attorney and Clerk Hire in Office of County Attorney in Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 130, amended. That part of section 130 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the county attorney and the assistant county attorney in Penobscot county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Penobscot, \$1,800 \$2,100; assistant county attoreny, \$1,000 \$1,200,'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to clerk hire in the office of county attorney in Penobscot county, is hereby amended to read as follows: 'for clerks in the office of county attorney, \$1,150.'
