RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Grant Right-of-way to Construct an Access Road Across the Public Lots in Township D, Range 2.

Forest commissioner to grant right-of-way. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to grant to the Penobscot Development Company, of Great Work, Maine, a right-of-way, not over 20 feet wide, for the construction of a gravel road 14 feet wide across Public Lots # 28, 27, 26 and 7 in Township D, Range 2, WELS, Aroostook county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

As a timber production work project the Public Roads Administration and the War Production Board have approved the construction of a gravel road in the vicinity of Bridgewater in Aroostook county, and the Maine state highway commission is constructing the same. The project starts at the end of the "Boots" road, so called, in Bridgewater, Maine, thence across the Donald McIntire Lot No. 29 on D, R. 2, thence across lots 28-27-26 and the southwesterly corner of Lot No. 7, on D, R. 2 in a northwesterly direction to the easterly line of Lot No. 8, belonging to the Penobscot Development Company, thence westerly across D, R. 2, thence southerly across Twp. 9, R. 3 to the north line of Twp. 8, R. 3. Lots 26-27-28 and 7 are Public Lots. The timber and grass on said public lots is owned by Madigan and Pierce et als.

The purpose of this road is to permit the hauling and transporting of pulpwood to be cut on lands of the Penobscot Development Company, on Twp. 3, R. 2, E, R. 2, 8, R. 3, WELS, Aroostook county, Maine, and will serve other timber land owners in the area.

This resolve in no way conveys any title to the land but merely gives the grantee right to use the land for purposes described.
