**RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for a Dam on the Marsh River.**

---

**Dam on Marsh river; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$5,000 to the county of Waldo, the town of Winterport and the town of Frankfort, to be used for the purpose of constructing a dam at West Winterport on the Marsh river.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

There are 3 bridges over the Marsh river which are in great danger of being washed away by flood waters unless a dam is erected.
