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**RESOLVE, Relating to Retirement Pension for Percy E. Averill, of Thomaston.**

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**Percy E. Averill; retirement pension. Resolved:** That Percy E. Averill, of Thomaston, now serving as night watch at the Maine State Prison, is hereby made eligible to receive a retirement pension under the provisions of section 3 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes of 1944.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This employee has been working at the prison since May 26, 1921, and he will be 69 years of age on May 8, 1945. He is afflicted with chronic arthritis and recently this has caused him so much suffering that it is difficult for Mr. Averill to perform his duties. He has been a faithful officer and has a fine record at the prison.
