**AN ACT Relating to Reenactment of Law Dealing with Unexpended
Appropriations.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 20-A, additional. Chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 20-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 20-A. Transfer of unexpended appropriations on recommendation of state budget officer. Any balance of any appropriation or subdivision of an appropriation made by the legislature for any state department, which at any time may not be required for the purposes named in such appropriation or subdivision may, upon recommendation of the budget officer, be transferred by the governor and council to any other appropriation or subdivision of an appropriation made by the legislature for the use of the same department for the same fiscal year.’
