STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Appropriation for Schools in Unorganized Territory and to the Funds for Teachers' Pensions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 146, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 146 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All of this appropriation not expended during any fiscal year shall, on the 1st day of July next following, ~~be added~~ lapse to the ~~permanent~~ state school fund.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37, § 219, amended. Section 219 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 219. Unexpended fund shall lapse to state school fund.** All of said school pension fund not distributed or expended in any fiscal year shall, on the 1st day of July next following, ~~be added~~ lapse to the ~~permanent~~ state school fund.'
