STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Authorizing the Highway Commission to Enter Upon Lands for Certain Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

'The commission and its authorized agents and employees may enter upon any lands, waters, and premises in the state for the purpose of making surveys, soundings, drillings and examinations, as it may deem necessary or convenient for the purpose of this chapter and such entry shall not be deemed a trespass.'
