AN ACT Clarifying the Law in Relation to Parkways and Freeways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 20, § 75, amended. Section 75 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted as section 19-A of said chapter 20:

‘Sec. 19-A. Commission may lay out and construct parkways and freeways. The state highway commission is authorized to lay out and construct any state highway as a parkway or a freeway road under the same conditions as set forth in section 19.’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 20, §§ 76-79, reallocated. Sections 76 to 79, inclusive, of chapter 20 of the revised statutes are hereby reallocated as sections 19-B to 19-E, inclusive, of said chapter 20.

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 20, §§ 76-79, amended. Wherever in sections 76 to 79 inclusive of chapter 20 of the revised statutes the phrase “sections 75 to 79” appears, the phrase “sections 19-B to 19-E” shall be substituted.
