AN ACT Relating to Advertising Resources, Etc., by Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 15-A, additional. Chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 15-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 15-A. Appropriation for advertising. Any county may extend not exceeding the sum of \$5,000, annually, under the direction of the county commissioners of said county, and accounted for as other moneys of said county, for advertising the natural resources, advantages and attractions of said county and for the purpose of relocating in said county discharged service men and women in gainful occupation, and the said commissioners are hereby authorized to employ, at such compensation as they deem reasonable, to be paid out of said fund, a suitable person or persons to advise and assist such service men and women in such relocation and to advise and assist in the advertising of such natural resources and advantages as exist in their respective counties.'
