**AN ACT Relating to Treatment of Employees Under the Workmen's
Compensation Act.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 26, § 9, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 9 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'During the first 30 days after the injury aforesaid the employee shall be entitled to reasonable and proper medical, surgical, and hospital services, nursing, medicines, and mechanical surgical aids, **or other remedial care or treatment**, when they are needed. The amount of such services and aids shall not exceed \$100 unless a longer period or a greater sum is allowed by the commission, which in its discretion it may allow when the nature of the injury or the process of recovery requires it.'
