### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Malt Liquor Package Stores.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 23-A, additional. Chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 23-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 23-A. Public notice of applications. No license to sell malt liquor not to be consumed on the premises shall be granted by the commission until the application for such license shall be given public notice at the applicant's expense.

The provisions of this section shall apply only to applications for premises whereon malt liquors not to be consumed on the premises have not been sold.'
