AN ACT Relating to Sale of Liquor to be Consumed on the Premises.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 38, amended. Section 38 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 38. Licenses for sale of liquor to be consumed on the premises, authorized. The commission may from time to time in cities and towns where state stores are in operation or where such stores have been authorized, either under the terms of the act creating the commission or at any biennial state election, grant licenses for the sale of liquor to be consumed on the premises where sold, in accordance with the provisions of ~~this chapter~~ **the local option law.'**
