STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Merton E. Grant, of Glenwood.

Merton E. Grant; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2,265.98 from the general highway fund to be paid to Merton E. Grant, of Glenwood, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his property and trespass thereon by the state highway commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Trespass and damage to meadow and brook and peace of mind; land taken; slash on said land taken; cut on hill by employees of the state, to-gether with trouble and inconvenience, amounted to the sum of \$2,265.98.
