AN ACT Relating to License Fees for Amusement Shows.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 88, § 53, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 53 of chapter 88 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No traveling circus or traveling amusement show shall exhibit any parade, show, or entertainment in this state without first paying a state license of \$500 in the case of a circus and **not less than \$25 nor more than \$500** in the case of amusement shows for each calendar year.'
