IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries
and Game.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 1-A, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 1-A, to read as follows :

‘**Sec. 1-A. Salary of commissioner.** The commissioner of inland fisheries and game shall receive an annual salary of \$6,000 and he shall also receive all necessary traveling expenses.’

Sec. 2. R. S., 1930, c. 125, § 23 and P. L., 1931, c. 270, repealed. Section 23 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes of 1930 and chapter 270 of the public laws of 1931 are hereby repealed.
