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**RESOLVE, Relating to Status of Pauper Settlement of Arthur Melvin  
Clewley.**

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**Pauper settlement of Arthur Melvin Clewley, established. Resolved:**  
That the commissioner of health and welfare be, and hereby is, authorized  
and directed to accept Arthur Melvin Clewley as a state pauper.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

It appears that Mr. Clewley has no pauper settlement in Etna, although the town of Etna, in a suit brought by the city of Bangor, erroneously stipulated that Mr. Clewley had a derivative settlement in Etna. Under present statutes it appears that Mr. Clewley is a state pauper and the town of Etna should not be charged with pauper supplies furnished him or those claiming derivative settlements through him.
