**RESOLVE, Relating to Dipping of Alewives in Machias River.**

---

**Dipping of alewives in Machias river; permitted. Resolved:** That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting the dipping of alewives with a hand net in the waters of Machias river Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of each week in an area defined as follows: Bounded westerly by a straight line running from the southeasterly corner of the Getchell Mill, so called, in a southeasterly direction to the easternmost end of the most southerly abutment of the concrete bridge, which abutment is on the southerly bank of said river, and bounded easterly by a straight line projected southerly from the southwesterly corner of the Bangor Hydro Electric Company power house along the same course as the southwesterly wall of said power house, to the southerly bank of said river; and to dip them with such net for 6 days a week from the waters of said river in the area northeasterly from the northeasterly side of the iron bridge so called.
