#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Fort Fairfield.

Town of Fort Fairfield; interest charged off. Resolved: That the state controller be, and hereby is, authorized to charge off the sum of \$2,468.01 now charged against the town of Fort Fairfield for interest on state taxes for the years 1935 and 1936.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Fort Fairfield owes the state \$2,468.01 as interest on state taxes. The town is heavily in debt and has no money to pay. The entire principal of all accounts due the state has been paid by such town.
