STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the City of Eastport for the Care of William Price.

City of Eastport; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2,816.31 from the general fund of the state to be paid to the city of Eastport for hospital care and treatment rendered to William Price, a patient in the Calais Hospital.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Price was admitted to the Calais Hospital, January 13, 1919 as a pauper, and has remained a patient of the said hospital to the present day, a matter of 26 years.

Since admittance to said hospital, he has lost both arms and both legs and therefore requires much care and attention, for which the city of Eastport has paid the hospital bill with the exception of the years

which were handled by the above-mentioned laws from state funds. The present resolve covers the period from October 8, 1943 to January 1, 1945.
