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**Francis M. Malcolm; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$140 from the appropriation for the department of agriculture to be paid to Francis M. Malcolm, of Windsorville, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for poultry killed by foxes.
