RESOLVE, in Favor of Francis M. Malcolm of Windsorville.

Francis M. Malcolm; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$140 from the appropriation for the department of agriculture to be paid to Francis M. Malcolm, of Windsorville, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for poultry killed by foxes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Malcolm did not report the damage within the time allowed, therefore the payment was not authorized by the selectmen.
