**RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Newport for Supplies Furnished
Fannie Norton of Newport.**

Town of Newport; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$337.45 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Newport, to reimburse said town for supplies furnished to Fannie Norton, of Newport, state pauper; said sums to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Between the years of 1930 and 1938, supplies were furnished Fannie Norton by the town of Newport in the amount of \$337.45. She has no settlement in the town of Newport.
