AN ACT Relative to Fee for Registration of Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 67, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 67 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The Commissioner shall establish game registration stations for the purpose of registering all deer killed. Said stations shall be in charge of an agent designated by the commissioner and a list of the same shall be published in one or more daily newspapers of the state. Said agent shall register each and every deer presented for registration, and shall tag each deer in the manner as directed and with the materials furnished by the commissioner. **Each person presenting a deer for registration shall pay to the game inspector a fee of \$1 for such registration. The money collected from this registration fee shall constitute a fund to be expended by the commissioner for wildlife research and the propagation of pheasants, rabbits and raccoons.'**
