STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Relating to Sale and Distribution of Index to Private and Special Laws.

Index to private and special laws; sale and distribution of. Resolved: That the attorney-general be, and hereby is, authorized to deliver to the state librarian all excess copies of the index digest to the private and special laws from 1820 to 1944, inclusive; and be it further

Resolved: That the state librarian be, and hereby is, authorized, with the approval of the governor and council, to fix the price at which such excess copies may be sold at wholesale, and shall thereafter make sales to bookstores at the price so fixed; and be it further

Resolved: That this resolve pertaining solely to facilitating the performance of the business of the state departments shall take effect when approved.
