AN ACT Relating to Exhibitions of Agricultural Societies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 26-A, additional. Chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 26-A to read as follows:

‘Sec. 26-A. Traveling amusement shows during exhibitions prohibited; penalty. No traveling amusement show shall operate, within 30 miles of the fair grounds of any agricultural society, during the 2 weeks immediately preceding or during the time of any exhibition thereof.

Whoever violates the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$2,000, or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.’
