STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Sheriffs and Expenses in Keeping Prisoners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 166, sub-§ XXXII, amended. Subsection XXXII of section 166 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'XXXII. For attending court and keeping the prisoner in criminal cases, \$1,50 for every 12 liours, and in that preparation for a greater or less time together with such reasonable sum as the court may allow for expenses incurred by the officer in employing a keeper, furnishing meals, or other necessities.'
