**RESOLVE, Relating to Dipping of Alewives in Certain Waters in
Machias, Washington County.**

Dipping of alewives, permitted. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting the dipping of alewives, for commercial purposes, from the southeast corner of the most south bridge to the northeast corner of the most north bridge in the town of Machias, Washington county.
