AN ACT Relating to the Transportation of Forest Products.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 85, amended. Section 85 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

‘And provided further, the state highway commission, upon written application, may grant permits for the transportation of farm machinery and loads of forest products of such height and width as it considers from time to time appropriate, over particular ways and bridges, upon such terms and conditions and for such periods as the commission shall determine.’
