**AN ACT Relating to Salary of Register of Probate and Clerks in Office
of Register of Probate in Hancock County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of the 6th paragraph of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of clerks in the office of register of probate in Hancock county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of probate, ~~\$1,560~~ \$2,600;'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 140, § 22, amended. That part of the 2nd paragraph of section 22 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the register of probate in Hancock county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Hancock, ~~\$1,200~~ \$1,800.'
