AN ACT Relating to Increase of Fees Allowed Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 103, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 103 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 6. Fees of jurors. Grand and traverse jurors, attending the superior court, and jurors, attending on any other occasion prescribed by law, shall be allowed ~~\$4~~ \$8 a day for their attendance, Sundays and holidays excepted, and 6c a mile for their travel out and home, to be paid out of the county treasury.'
