**RESOLVE, to Provide for Construction of a State Garage.**

---

**State garage; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$150,000 to construct a state garage. This sum shall be expended by the state purchasing agent to procure a site and build a garage in Augusta suitable for the repair and maintenance of state-owned cars.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the present time a portion of the state highway garage is used as a state garage for the storage and servicing of state-owned cars. The space now used would be inadequate for an increased fleet of cars and is needed by the highway department.
